Quotes:

- All prices quoted are in Australian dollars and are inclusive of GST.
- Proposed itineraries are subject to availability at the time of booking.
- All prices quoted are based on the numbers stated. Any change to tour numbers will require a revised quote.
- For Canberra tours, the PACER rebate has not been deducted from the tour price.
- Quotes inclusive of airfare prices are estimated based on quotes from applicable airlines, and are subject to change until booked.

Deposits:

- In order to confirm your tour, a minimum deposit of \$50.00 per paying passenger is payable, along with the signed Booking Terms and Conditions Form. If airfares and/or ferry fares are included in your tour, an additional deposit of a minimum of \$50.00 per paying passenger will also be payable.
- An invoice for all applicable deposit payments will be sent with your quote letter. The invoice will be payable within 10 working days from receipt unless alternative arrangements have been made.
- On receipt of applicable deposits and the signed Booking form, all air, sea, and land bookings will be made.
- If travel includes air or sea transport, you will also be subject to the carriers terms and conditions.

Itinerary & Pricing Confirmation:

- Once all bookings are in place, a confirmed itinerary will be sent out, inclusive of all timings. We will advise if any timings change prior to departure. Any amendments or changes to your confirmed itinerary will incur fees.
- Additional information will also be sent out inclusive of a Dietary Form, Travel Insurance, any names list templates, applicable waivers/indemnity forms, website links, etc.
- A confirmed tour price will also be given, based on the current number of students and staff/adults. Please note that if the student/staff/adult numbers change, it may be necessary to recost your tour.
- The confirmed tour price does not include travel insurance (unless otherwise stated), airline fuel surcharges, airline price increases, coach fuel surcharges, excess baggage charges or personal expenses. All meals included are listed on the itinerary.
